ETIQUETTE

- Every player must pay a green fee before play. Green fees are not transferable or refundable.
- Players must be properly dressed and wear appropriate footwear.
- A maximum of 4 players is permitted in each match and each player must have a set of golf clubs in bag.
- All matches must commence from the 1st tee and players must use the allocated tee at each hole - Men's - yellow Ladies - red, Juniors - red.
- Please replace divots on fairways, repair pitch marks on greens and fill and smooth footprints in bunkers.
- A match losing place on the course by one clear hole must allow the following match through and out of range. Please play without delay - only five minutes is permitted to find a lost ball. ALLOW players coming up to play through.
- A single player has NO standing on the course and must give way to all matches who wish to play through.
- Trolleys must not be taken on to tees, greens, ground under repair or into bunkers or hazards.
- The directives of the Golf Professional and Course Warden must be complied with at all times.
- Golfers play the course at their own risk. Guidance notes are displayed on the Customer Information Board outside the Golf Shop.



If there are 2 flags on each hole the course is marked for Power Play Golf. If you are not playing Power Play Golf ignore the black flag. Full rules of Power Play Golf are available from the Golf Shop.



6th, 8th and 9th holes and the three ponds to the left of the 2nd and 3rd holes are water hazards. Yellow posts indicate a water hazard, red posts indicate a lateral water hazard.

5. GROUND UNDER REPAIR

a) Heavy tyre marks through the green are ground under repair. Rule 25.2b applies.

b) Fractures of young trees are ground under repair from which play is prohibited. Relief **MUST** be taken under Rule 25.1c.

6. PREFERRED LIES

For the preservation of the course winter rules are

permanently in force. A ball lying on any closely mown area, through the green may, without penalty, be mowed or may be cleaned and placed within 5' of where it originally lay, but not nearer the hole. After the ball has been so moved or placed, it is in play, and it moved after the player has addressed it, the penalty shall be a stroke. Rule 18-2e.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES

Match Play - Loss of Hole

Stroke Play - Two Strokes.

NOTE: Players should not try to retrieve a ball from over the fence along the right of the 3rd hole, or from over the fence behind the 5th green and along the right of the 5th hole. Players doing so may be prosecuted for trespass.
